

K. N. Rao Mathematics Competition

The Twenty Second Annual K. N. Rao Mathematics Competition will be held on Saturday, the 14th of October at 9:30 am in Minard 342. This is an annual competition held to commemorate the memory of Professor K. N. Rao of the Department of Mathematics of NDSU.

The competition is a contest of individual mathematical knowledge and expertise as measured by the participant's performance on a series of written problems. The expectation of preparation for this contest is calculus and an introductory course in linear algebra.

There will be prizes for the top competitors. The top prize winner will have their name engraved in the K. N. Rao trophy. The top five competitors will be awarded gift certificates for the NDSU Varsity Mart. There are also scholarships that can be utilized at NDSU.

1st prize: \$ 50 gift certificate \$ 250 NDSU scholarship
2nd prize: \$ 40 gift certificate \$ 200 NDSU scholarship
3rd prize: \$ 30 gift certificate \$ 150 NDSU scholarship
4th prize: \$ 20 gift certificate
5th prize: \$ 10 gift certificate
